

COMMUNITY CONSULTATION ON HOUSING OPTIONS IN CHILBOLTON

01 September 2026

Dear Resident,

Chilbolton Parish Council has commissioned Action Hampshire to carry out an independent consultation to understand local views on housing options within the parish. The purpose of this consultation is to gather the views of people who live in to Chilbolton in a structured and transparent way. The results will help inform the Parish Council's future discussions about housing and will contribute to the ongoing evidence gathering and community engagement process.

Action Hampshire is an independent charity that provides the Rural Housing Enabler service across Hampshire. We do not build, own or manage housing and have no financial interest in any future development. Our role is simply to carry out the consultation independently and report the findings objectively.

How to take part

Enclosed with this letter is a Consultation Card containing your unique identification number. You can respond in either of two ways:

Online: Visit www.surveymonkey.com/r/Chilbolton or scan the QR code on your Consultation Card. You will need to enter your unique identification number before completing the consultation.

By Consultation Card: Complete the enclosed Consultation Card, place it in the envelope provided and deposit it in one of the three sealed consultation boxes located at: Abbott's Mitre Pub, the Village Shop, or the Village Hall, each accessible during premises normal opening hours.

All response must be submitted by: Sunday 27 September 2026.

Only one response may be submitted using each unique identification number.

Response Options

Option 1: Drove Road - 75 homes (Developer-led)

Option 2: Drove Road - approx. 20 homes (Community-led)

Option 3: Gravel Hill - approx. 20 homes (Community-led)

Option 4: No Community-led Development at all

Your response

The consultation requires you to rank the four options in order of preference.

You MUST rank all four options, failure to do so will invalidate your submission.

- Rank 1 should be your most preferred option.
- Rank 4 should be your least preferred option.
- You must rank all four options for your response to be included in the final results.

The results will be analysed using a weighted ranking system to ensure all preferences are considered.

Confidentiality

All responses will be treated in confidence by Action Hampshire. Your unique identification number is used solely to verify that each eligible participant submits only one response. See overleaf for details.

PRIVACY NOTICE AND FURTHER INFORMATION

Thank you for taking part in the Chilbolton Community Consultation on Housing Options. Action Hampshire has been commissioned by Chilbolton Parish Council to independently manage this consultation and analyse the results. We are committed to protecting your privacy and handling all information securely and in accordance with UK data protection legislation.

Why we are collecting this information

The purpose of this consultation is to understand community preferences regarding future housing options in Chilbolton. The results will be used to help inform future discussions and decision-making by Chilbolton Parish Council and other relevant stakeholders.

How your response will be used

Your response will be collected and analysed by Action Hampshire, included in a statistical report summarising the consultation findings, reported only in an anonymised and aggregated form, and used solely for the purposes of this consultation. Individual responses will not be shared with Chilbolton Parish Council or any other organisation.

Unique Identification Number

Each eligible participant has been allocated a unique identification number. This identification number is used solely to verify eligibility to participate, prevent duplicate responses, and ensure the integrity of the consultation process. The register linking names and identification numbers is held securely by Action Hampshire and will not be shared with Chilbolton Parish Council or any other stakeholder. Once a response has been submitted, it cannot be amended or withdrawn.

Data Protection

Action Hampshire acts as the Data Controller and Data Processor for this consultation. We will store information securely, restrict access to authorised members of staff only, ensure personal information is not disclosed unnecessarily, and handle all data in accordance with UK GDPR and Data Protection legislation.

Action Hampshire may use trusted third-party providers, such as SurveyMonkey, to assist with processing consultation responses. Consultation responses and related records will be retained securely for up to 12 months following completion of the project and will then be permanently deleted.

Who Can Take Part?

This consultation is open to adults living within Chilbolton Parish who have received a Consultation Card. Only one response may be submitted per unique identification number.

Do I have to rank all four options?

Yes. To ensure consistent analysis, respondents **MUST** rank all four options from 1 (most preferred) to 4 (least preferred). Responses that do not contain a complete ranking will not be counted.
